POLICIES FOR THE ANTI-RAGGING COMMITTEE

2024-25

1. **Zero Tolerance Policy:** Any form of ragging, whether physical, psychological, or verbal, will not be tolerated. Strict action will be taken against offenders as per UGC and AICTE regulations.
2. **Awareness and Orientation:**
 - Conduct workshops, seminars, and induction programs to educate students about the consequences of ragging.
 - Display anti-ragging posters and guidelines in common areas like canteens, and classrooms.
3. **Affidavit Submission:**
 - All students and their parents/guardians must submit an anti-ragging affidavit at the time of admission, ensuring compliance with the institution's code of conduct.
4. **24/7 Complaint Mechanism:**
 - Establish a dedicated anti-ragging helpline number and email for students to report incidents confidentially.
 - Install complaint boxes at key locations within the campus for anonymous reporting.
5. **Surveillance and Monitoring:**
 - Deploy CCTV cameras in hostels, corridors, and other sensitive areas to prevent ragging activities.
 - Conduct surprise inspections by faculty members in common student areas.
6. **Counselling and Mentorship:**
 - Assign faculty mentors to students, especially fresher's, to provide guidance and emotional support.
 - Encourage peer mentoring programs where senior students support juniors in academic and personal growth.
7. **Immediate Disciplinary Action:**
 - Form a special inquiry committee to investigate ragging complaints within 48 hours of reporting.
 - Implement punishments ranging from suspension to rustication, depending on the severity of the offense.
 - Legal action will be taken against students found guilty of ragging, in coordination with local law enforcement.
